Purpose: To advise the City Forester, Council, and Mayor on tree-related issues and promote awareness of tree care, Hartford's arboreal heritage, and benefits of urban forest

The Commission develops and adopts a Master Tree Plan, reviews the plan every five years, and amends it as needed; creates an annual "State of the Forest" report; prepares policy and action recommendations to submit to Mayor and Council; hears and decides appeals from City Forester; and establishes a Legacy Tree Program

The Forestry Division works closely with and is supported by the Tree Advisory Commission.
